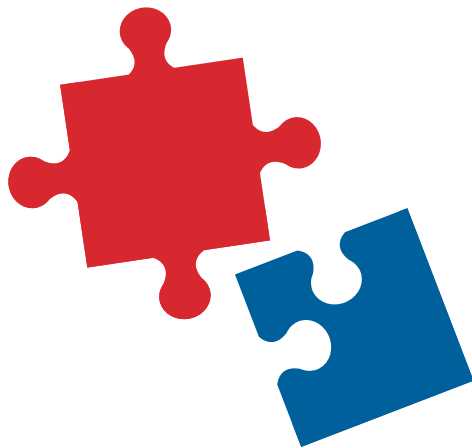

## WORD SEARCH PUZZLE



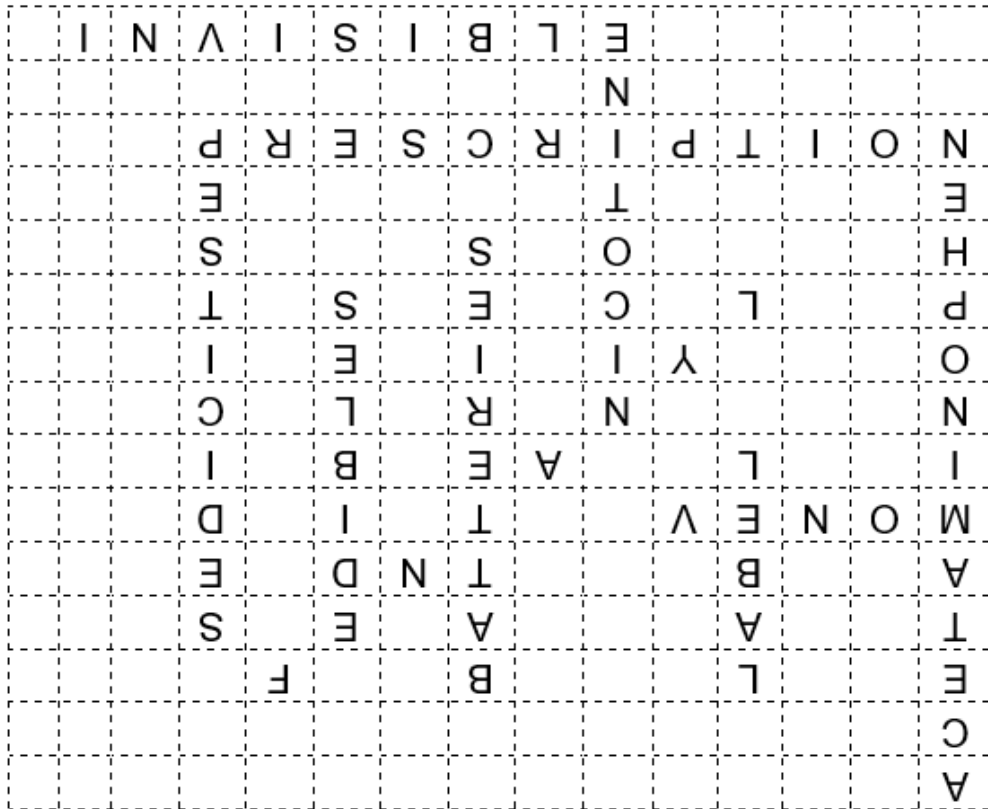

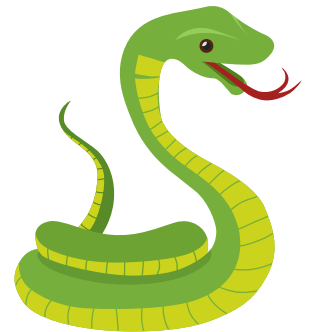
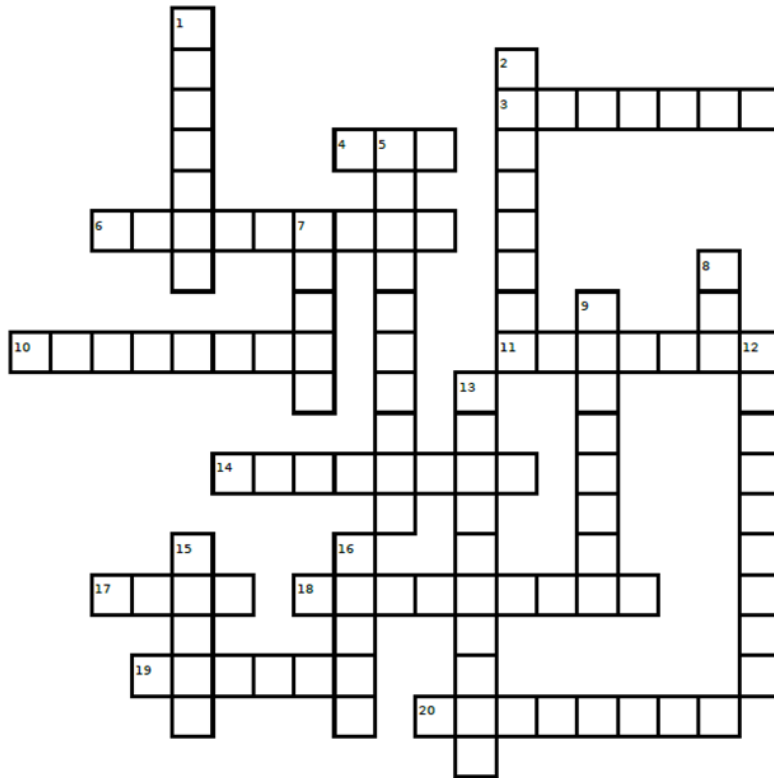
